

The **Lippitt Club Awards** are a means of honoring Club members and individual Lippitt Morgan horses for their outstanding achievements.

Our current awards are: The Lippitt of the Year Award, the Allen's Major Award, the Morgan Tiffany Riviezzo Award for Youth, the Nancy Plimpton Perpetual Award, and the T/RAP.

THE ROBERT LIPPITT KNIGHT TROPHY FOR LIPPITT OF THE YEAR,

This award is the highest honor a Lippitt Morgan can earn. It is awarded by the Lippitt Club to the full Lippitt who in the preceding year has generated the greatest amount of favorable notice for the Lippitt Morgan. The award was established in 1975 to encourage the promotion of the Lippitts through their use before the public. Although activities in the years PRIOR to the previous year (year for which the honor is bestowed) may be considered in a close decision, it is activities in the preceding year which are emphasized.

THE ALLEN'S MAJOR AWARD

Annual High Point Lippitt Versatile Show Horse Competition This competition is the brainchild of Anne Ashby of Auburn, New York. She and Gerry most generously donated a trophy in the memory of their great stallion Allen's Major. It is the hope of the Ashbys that this competition will inspire more Lippitt owners to get out and show, so that horse lovers will be reminded that there are still old-type Morgans in the world. As Anne wrote, "If we can get a lot more old-type Morgans in the show ring, they will not be overlooked.

THE MORGAN TIFFANY RIVIEZZO AWARD for THE LIPPITT CLUB YOUTH OF THE YEAR

This award was introduced in 2006 in memory of Morgan Tiffany Riviezzo, who died in her youth of cancer. The award is to honor and to encourage a deserving young person who bas demonstrated a caring interest and commitment for the Lippitt Morgan, as well as the purposes of the Lippitt Club. The future of the Lippitt Morgan is in the hands of our youth.

THE NANCY PLIMPTON PERPETUAL AWARD

The "Nancy Plimpton Perpetual Award" is presented with the intent that it be used as an annual award given to a living person {s} in recognition of years of commitment and service to the "Lippitt Morgan". This award may be given in recognition of an individual {s} or partnership who have devoted much time and effort over the years to the promotion and perpetuation of the select family of Morgan horses known as the "Lippitt Morgan" This award may be presented only one time to any designated recipient.

TRAILBLAZER and REINSMAN AWARD PROGRAM (T/RAP)

The purpose of this program is to provide recognition for Lippitt Club members who use their Lippitts outside the show ring and other competitive situations. Forms, found with the application, are used to record the hours the members ride or drive their Lippitts. When the required amount of hours are reached, the forms are returned and a certificate, patches and other awards for the particular level of hours attained are issued. Half Lippitts may be used, as they are considered to be an avenue wherein the member and others are introduced to the value of the full Lippitt.
